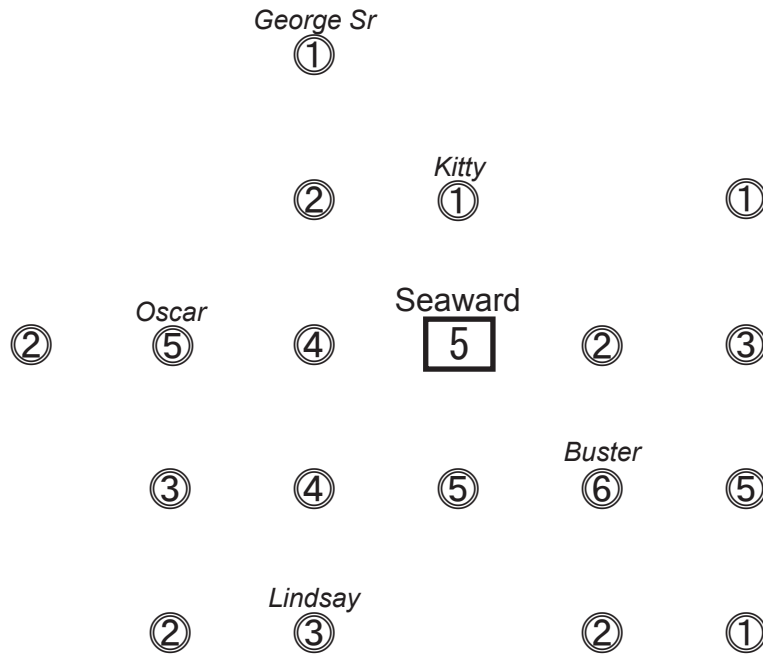

In this diagram of an unfilmed scene from Arrested Develoment, several of the characters are in the Newport Beach marina trying to get to the Seaward. Not being particularly familiar with the family yacht, they have all boarded different boats (as indicated). And that’s when GOB’s magic trick, pardon me, grand illusion takes effect, making the jetties of the marina disappear. Although there are no walkways, there are still ropes connecting the boats to each other, and the characters, in their zeal to claim a briefcase onboard the Seaward, traverse the lines to that yacht.

The camera will cut from GOB saying, “I can’t believe that actually worked. I mean, ta-da!”, to each character in turn, showing their route to the Seaward. We’ll start with Kitty, on the closest boat to the Seaward, and we’ll watch her carefully cross to the yacht. Cut to Buster, who handily moves from his starting boat to another, and to the Seaward. Now camera on George Sr, he moves from his starting boat to another, then another, then boards the Seaward. Cut to his twin brother Oscar, who moves from his starting boat, to a boat George Sr was on, then to the Seaward. Cut to Lindsay, who moves from her starting boat, to another, turns and crosses to another boat, then turns the other direction and crosses to the Seaward.

The scene ends with an interior shot of the Seaward and the five characters struggling with the heavy briefcase, which of course flies open, scattering these everywhere.
